**GRAYS HARBOR COUNTY REGION  
SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (STP)  
APPROVAL FOR FUNDING**

**WHEREAS**, the Grays Harbor Council of Governments (GHCOG) legally serves as the Lead Agency and Funding Authority for the Grays Harbor County Region Surface Transportation Program (STP) process; and,

**WHEREAS**, there are new requirements for STP regarding the timeline for expending allocated funds; and,

**WHEREAS**, the region must close out and obligate all final SAFETEA-LU money and 2013 MAP-21 federal fiscal year allocation consisting of \$2,181,173 before the end of the federal fiscal year 2013 or the funding will be eliminated; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Grays Harbor County Region STP Technical Advisory Committee has reviewed and rated the projects according to due process; and,

**WHEREAS**, the results of that rating and funding request are as follows:

Elma E. Main St. – Old SR12 to East City Limits PE	\$ 100,000
GHCOG - Gateway Mall Access Improvements, planning study	\$ 600,000
Grays Harbor County – 2013 Cities & County Paving Project	\$ 747,173
Hoquiam – Downtown Ped/Bike Safety Project, addtn'l money	\$ 250,000
McCleary 3 <sup>rd</sup> Street Improvements PE	\$ 237,000
Montesano – Main St. Phase II, addtn'l money	\$ 87,000
Montesano – East Pioneer Ave. PE	\$ 160,000
<b>TOTAL PROJECTS</b>	<b><u>\$2,181,173</u></b>
