**Approval of the Grays Harbor Council of Governments
2023-2028 Transportation Improvement Plan**

WHEREAS, agencies anticipating federal transportation funding must develop an annual six-year Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP); and,

WHEREAS, the Grays Harbor Council of Governments (GHCOG) anticipates receiving federal funds from the Surface Transportation Program for planning; and,

WHEREAS, funded projects include STP Administration 2023, 2024, 2025, & 2026 and planned projects include; Grays Harbor Regional Rail Study, Regional Intelligent Transportation Systems, GH Communities Walking and Biking Path Planning & Implementation Program, and the Regional Trails Planning Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Grays Harbor Council of Governments approves their 2023 – 2028 TIP. It is the intent of the GHCOG that this TIP serves to fulfill the requirements of both the State of Washington and the Federal Government as it relates to the funding requirements and applicable laws.
