**Amendment No. 1 to the 2023-2030  
Grays Harbor County Region  
Surface Transportation Program (STP)  
Approval for Funding**

**WHEREAS**, the Grays Harbor Council of Governments (GHCOG) legally serves as the Lead Agency and Funding Authority for the Grays Harbor County Region Surface Transportation Program (STP) process; and,

**WHEREAS**, under the 2016, 2017, 2018 regional funding round under the MAP-21 Act as identified in Resolution #594, allocated \$527,161 to the City of Aberdeen for the Downtown Revitalization Traffic Improvements (CN); and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Aberdeen has requested to return those funds and re-apply at a later date; and the City of Montesano has requested use of those funds on their East Pioneer Improvements Phase 1 (CN) and assures they can meet all timeline obligations; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Grays Harbor County Region STP Technical Advisory Committee has met and discussed this change in project funding according to due process; and,

**WHEREAS**, the results of changes in funding allocations are as follows:

**GHCOG** – 2029 PL - STP Administrative Planning = \$65,000

**Port of Grays Harbor** – 2028 PE - Myrtle Street & Henderson Street Pavement = \$47,326  
**Port of Grays Harbor** – 2029 CN - Myrtle Street & Henderson Street Pavement = \$224,228  
**McCleary** – 2024 PE - South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street = \$310,000  
**McCleary** – 2026 ROW - South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street = \$143,320  
**McCleary** – 2029 CN - South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street = \$1,108,000  
**Montesano** – 2026 PE – South Main Street Recon = \$173,000  
**Montesano** – 2028 ROW - South Main Street Recon = \$103,800  
**Montesano** – 2030 PE – West Pioneer Ave Recon = \$173,000

**Westport – 2027 PE - South Montesano Street = \$173,000**  
**Westport – 2030 ROW - South Montesano Street = \$242,000**  
**TOTAL PROJECTS      \$ 7,878,915**

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that serving as the STP County Region Policy Board, the GHCOG hereby approves STP funding amounts for the projects listed above.
