5. ALL-STAFF REPORT

Vicki Cummings, Executive Director

- Only received one response on Brownfield RFQ. Hoping EPA will grant exception for only having one response, so another RFQ doesn't have to be run.
- Worked on finalizing the UPWP at last CWCOG meeting.
- The CWCOG has scheduled in-person Transportation Policy Forums for May 15th and October 16th.
- USDOT is asking for input on goals, thresholds, and data sources on freight that could impact our critical rural freight designation.
- The five county Regional Trails Plan is close to completion.

- Attended a trails meeting and did a site visit with the trail consultants.
- Submitted final STP billings now that Cost Allocation Plan was approved.
- Closed out STP 2023 Administration.
- Submitted packet to obligate STP 2024 Administration.
- Worked to rectify tax withholding issues so can properly reconcile payroll.

6. MEMBER/PUBLIC COMMENT

Timberland Library, Library Manager Karen Kienenburger

• The TRL Digital Navigator, which was funded from a Google grant, comes to the local libraries to help patrons with their technical devices, with finding low-cost internet providers, and other computer related services. Some locations require a reservation, and some are drop-in only. Check the events calendar for details.

➤ City of Ocean Shores, City Administrator Scott Anderson

- Working on a 5-year Streets Master Plan & a Fresh Waterways Master Plan.
- The High Dunes Trail is open and now has a Pocket Park at the trail's north end.
- Working on completion of the Chinook Dog Park.

- Starting in 2025 the Army Corps of Engineers and Ecology will invest 40 million to fix the jetty, but the remnant jetty will still need to be replaced.
- Lots of events are going on at the Convention Center. Check out the calendar.
- The city is still getting lots of requests for building permits and is close to becoming larger than Hoquiam soon.
- Sidewalks are the next priority for the city to focus on.

➤ City of Hoquiam, Councilmember Brandon Pauley

• Due to issues with sound the only part of the member comment that was heard was that the city approved their Hazard Mitigation Plan.

➤ City of Oakville, Councilmember Bill Breedlove

- This was Bill's introductory meeting with GHCOG.
- Committed to being involved with GHCOG and the community.

City of Westport, Mayor Troy Meyers

- A new City Council Member resigned. They received 6 applications to replace the position and have narrowed it down to 4 applicants for which they will meet with on the 29th.
- Met with state agencies in the fall and there were concerns about wildfires in the state parks, so the city has gotten a contract with Firewise.
- The council voted to approve the purchase of the professional building.
- The city is doing a review of all the city owned parcels.
- Planning upgrades to parks for softball and baseball.

Grays Harbor Transit, General Manager Ken Mehin

- Thanks to Mayor Miller for inviting Ken to come out to give input on the transit station revitalization project.
- May 6th the new Wave services start in Hoquiam.
- A weekday Shuttle is starting in Hoquiam.
- Weekend Dial-a-Ride services are starting in Ocean Shores.
- Wave weekend services are starting in Aberdeen.

Port of Grays Harbor, Commissioner Phil Papac

- The Port is very busy.
- The Port Staff are doing great work.
- T4 expansion is moving forward.

City of Elma, Mayor Josh Collette

• Lost connection before member comment.

➤ City of McCleary, Mayor Chris Miller

- Thanks to Ken Mehin for coming out to give input on the transit station revitalization project.
- The Comprehensive Plan is out for Public Hearing, which is part of Commerce's 60-day review process.
- A contract was awarded to Gray and Osborne for the Maple Street Sidewalk's.

City of Cosmopolis, Mayor Linda Springer

- The city fund is moving into the black.
- The municipal building is on track and Roglins expects it to be completed by January of 2025.
- The city signed a 9-month interlocal agreement with Aberdeen for police services.
- Received an RCO grant for \$100,000 for Mill Creek.
- Applied for a Sports grant from RCO for Lion's Park.
- Working on a comprehensive storm water plan with Hoquiam for which Mr. Chestnut and Mr. Skinner will be Cosmopolis' representatives.
- The city's Comprehensive Park Plan should be completed by June.
- The city will be having a Spring Cleanup sponsored by WSU.
- There will be a Local Artist Festival July 13th.
- Volunteers are taking on projects at the local parks and even donating money.

- Roglins is starting roadwork on Pioneer Street, which will run through July.
- The Lake Sylvia Sidewalk project is getting underway.
- Lake Sylvia will be closed for construction June 10th through September 30th to replace a culvert.
- The city is looking to hire a new Police Chief.
